












Academic Curriculum


But the use of smart calasses modern technology eases the learning process for all students. Moreover, this Kind of education in class promotes more interaction between teacher and student with more participation process.

Hostel Facility...

Settlement of account will be entertained/made only on the submission of a letter of request and receipts in original to the principle.


After conformation of admission into the collage, information regarding commencement of classes for CBSE XI &XII be communicated to the parents in due course.



NOTE

- 1. a) Amount of Rs. 5,500/- (Rupees Five Thousand Five Hundred) only is paid toward reservation of seat (hostel). The right to allot or reject the seat into CBSE-XI if the student does not get 60% of mark in Std 'X' is at the discretion of the Management only
 - b) Allotment of campus and section is at the sole discretion of the management. The management reserves the right to shift the student from one campus to another campus




Rules to be followed ...

For the Students:
